TERMS OF REFERENCE

Provision of Food for the Competition Law and Policy Seminar Series Competition Economics on the Digital Economy

I. Rationale/Objective

The Philippine Competition Commission (PCC) is an independent quasi-judicial body with the original and primary jurisdiction in the enforcement and regulation of all competition-related issues. It is mandated to implement the Philippine Competition Act, ensure economic efficiency and promote free and fair competition in trade, industry and all commercial and economic activities.

As a newly-instituted competition agency, the PCC will have to intensify its efforts to capacitate its staff to ensure that they efficiently and effectively carry out PCC's mandate and to establish a system of continued skills upgrading of PCC organic staff.

In view of this, the PCC will conduct the **Competition Law and Policy Seminar Series:** *Competition Economics on the Digital Economy* on 22-23 November 2018 at the UP School of Economics, Quezon City. An external service provider shall be contracted to provide catering services.

II. Participants

The event will gather 50-60 persons including resource speakers, PCC officials and staff, and PCC partners.

III. Scope of Work and Job Specifications

A. Conference/Function Rooms and Food Requirements

- The following meal requirements will be provided: For 22 and 23 November 2018
 - > Free flowing coffee, tea, and water
 - > AM Snack, Buffet Lunch, PM Snacks for 50-60 pax
 - ➤ AM Snack will be served at 10:00am, Lunch at 12:00pm and PM Snacks at 3:00pm
 - > Drinks: One round of iced tea or lemonade during lunch and snacks
 - > Provision of mints/candies
 - > Provision of Tables and Chairs
- Caterer is also required to bring tables and chairs for the buffet set-up at the venue.

IV. Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)

The ABC is One Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (Php 140,000) inclusive of all applicable government taxes and service charges. In case of additional participants, cost per participant will be charged accordingly.

V. Evaluation and Selection Criteria (Rating Scheme)

Bid proposals shall be evaluated following the criteria prescribed under Appendix 7 of the revised IRR of RA9184. In addition, the service provider should attach to its bid proposal a filled-out form in Annex A of this document.

VI. Mode of Procurement

The mode of procurement shall be under Negotiated Procurement pursuant to the revised IRR of RA 9184 which covers provision of food, venue, and other facilities.

VII. Payment Scheme

Full payment of the contract shall be made after the issuance of the following:

- a. Billing statement by the Service Provider; and
- b. Certificate of Satisfactory Service issued by PCC.

VIII. Liquidated Damages

Failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions of the contract will result in the payment of corresponding penalties/liquidated damages in the amount equal to 10 percent of the contract price by the winning service provider. The agency reserves the right to rescind the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

IX. Dispute Agreement/Resolution:

In the matter of dispute, should any dispute related to the Contract and/or rights of the parties arise, the same shall be submitted to mutual consultation, mediation and arbitration, in the order of application. The venue of the proceedings shall be in Quezon City.

In case of a court suit, the venue shall be the courts of competent jurisdiction in Quezon City, to the exclusion of all other courts; and

Any amendment or additional terms and conditions to the Contract must be in writing, signed and acknowledged by the Parties.
