TERMS OF REFERENCE

Procurement of Training Service Provider for the Conduct of Foundations of Digital Forensics

I. Rationale/Objective

The Competition Enforcement Office (CEO) primarily investigates and prosecutes cases involving alleged violations of the Philippine Competition Act, its implementing rules and regulations, and other existing competition-related laws. In order to effectively perform its investigation and prosecution functions, the CEO would require a workable understanding and appreciation of digital forensics, including retrieval, extraction and extrapolation of numerous data, a skill that is crucial in investigations, case build ups and prosecutions.

To strengthen its capacity, the CEO intends to have a two-day training on Foundations of Digital Forensics provided by an external provider on 19-20 November 2018.

An external service provider shall be contracted to provide training services for the said workshop.

II. Participants

The training will gather 25 participants, including PCC officials and employees.

III. Scope of Work, Deliverables and Schedule

The Training Service Provider (TSP) shall perform the following tasks:

IV. Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)

A total estimated ABC for this procurement is Two Hundred Twenty-two Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty Pesos (Php222,880.00), inclusive of all applicable government taxes and service charges. The ABC is also inclusive of all costs incurred relevant in the pre-conduct, actual day-event and required post-activities

V. Required Qualifications

TSPs that are legally registered in PhilGEPS and with BIR Tax Certificate/Clearance are eligible to apply. The trainers must possess the following minimum qualifications:

- Educational attainment of master's degree or university/undergraduate degree;
- 2. At least five (5) years of relevant work experience in the field of IT or other similar fields;
- 3. Engaged with five (5) similar or relevant projects in the past three (3) years; and
- 4. Core competencies required:
 - Strong training and facilitation skills;
 - Demonstrated MS Office, management, programming/system administration, cybersecurity, and other technical skills;
 - Punctuality and time management ability to meet deadlines;
 - Demonstrable experience in conducting courses on digital forensics;
 and
 - Experience in working in government/projects is an advantage

VII. Mode of Procurement

The mode of procurement shall be **Negotiated Procurement - Small Value Procurement for Consulting Services** provided under the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184.

VIII. Payment Scheme

The PCC shall pay the consultant within fifteen (15) working days upon receipt of the original signed Statement of Account, or billing statement, supported by a Certificate of Satisfactory Service Rendered to be issued by the end-user, and upon completion of all the deliverables / documentary requirements.

IX. Liquidated Damages

Failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions of the contract will result in the payment of corresponding penalties/liquidated damages in the amount equal to one-tenth of one percent (1%) of the cost of unperformed portion for every day of delay. If the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of contract. The PCC reserves the right to rescind the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

X. Dispute Agreement/Resolution:

Should any dispute related to the TOR and/or rights of the parties arise, the same shall be submitted to mutual consultation, mediation and arbitration, in the order of application. The venue of the proceedings shall be in Quezon City.

In case of a court suit, the venue shall be the courts of competent jurisdiction in Quezon City, to the exclusion of all other courts; and
