<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The steps to carry out the different activities of the TOR are discussed generically. The approach is standard and not specifically tailored to the assignment. Although the approach and methodology are suitable, they don't include a discussion on how the offeror proposes to deal with critical characteristics of the assignment.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The approach and/or methodology to carry out important activities indicated in the TOR are inappropriate or very poorly presented, indicating that the offeror has misunderstood important aspects of the scope of work.

Decision points and the sequence and timing of activities are very well defined, indicating that the offeror has optimized the use of resources. The work plan is explained in relation to the proposed approach and permits flexibility to accommodate contingencies.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> The work plan fits the TOR well; all important activities are indicated in the activity schedule and their timing is appropriate and consistent with the assignment outputs; and the interrelation between the various activities is realistic and consistent with the proposed approach. There is a fair degree of detail that facilitates understanding of the proposed work plan.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> All key activities are included in the activity plan, but they are not detailed. There are minor inconsistencies between timing, assignment outputs, and proposed approach.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> The activity plan omits important tasks; the timing of activities and correlation among them is inconsistent with the approach and/or methodology proposed. There is lack of clarity and logic in the sequencing.
