• Seven (7) potential bidders were present during the pre- bid conference as enumerated above.	
• The following questions/ concerns were raised during the meeting:	Answers:
 Source Telecoms made a clarification on how many ports will PCC require on the Bandwidth Manager and Router. 	Bandwidth Manager – at least eight (8) ports Routers – at least twelve (12) ports
2. In relation to section VI.b.4 of the TOR to provide a manageable DNS Server (DNS Server and Administrator Account), Source Telecoms asked for clarification whether they need to provide a physical DNS server that can be manage in PCC Data Center or just to provide with DNS hosting service. In addition, in case PCC requires only DNS hosting service, is there a need to have an administrator account and a remote management from PCC's end.	A cloud DNS hosting service is acceptable, as long it can be remotely managed, manageable, and PCC is provided with an administrator account.
3. Source Telecoms made clarification regarding PCC requirement for a secondary DNS, that bidder needs to provide two (2) Physical DNS server if happens that PCC require a Physical DNS server.	PCC require only one (1) cloud DNS hosting service, the secondary DNS can be provided by the Internet Service

		Provider (ISP) not managed by PCC.
4.	Eastern Telecommunications Philippines Inc. asked the end-user to state the required specifications of the router and bandwidth manager.	No required specifications other than the number of ports.
5.	Microsource Inc. asked for how many IP should PCC require per ISP provider for the 14 IP's needed.	The supplier and partner ISP can decide on the breakdown of the 14 public IP.
6.	Eastern Telecoms and Philippine Telegraph & Telephone Corp. asked for consideration to lower the required client satisfactory of 100 Mbps to 50 Mbps considering the 2 IPs will provide only 50 Mbps each IP.	End-user to consider the request and will issue supplemental/bid bulletin if there will be changes. If none, the said requirement will remain the same.
7.	Bidders asked for ocular inspection.	Schedule for ocular inspection will be on November 22, 2018. Bidders to submit names of their representatives at least a day before the schedule.
•	For possible Supplemental/Bid Bulletin:	
1.	Provide and configure redundant bandwidth manager appliance or any WAN bonding equipment and must be configure for high availability configuration.	
2.	Provide and configure redundant routing equipment compatible with bandwidth manager and must be configure for high availability configuration.	
3.	Provide a manageable DNS Server.	
4.	Assign Public Internet Protocol (IP) Addresses to the Commission.	
	Provision of at least 14 usable Public IP Addresses (Public IP Address must be sources from the two ISP provider on a 50:50 ratio).
