 Part II of the Pre-Bidding conference –Terms of Reference (TOR) for the project was presented by the end-user. 	
B. Project Description and Technical Requirements	
• Comprehensive maintenance is essential in ensuring the equipment operates at peak performance to lessen the likelihood of failures and to reduce the risk of downtime. A Comprehensive Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Maintenance Services (CIMS) will decrease the total cost of investment by extending the equipment life, reduce repair costs, improve reliability, decrease costs of replacement, and decrease downtime of operation.	
C. Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)	
 The total ABC for this project is PhP 7,600,000.00, broken down as follows: Lot 1 – PhP 1,500,000.00 Lot 2 – PhP 2,500,000.00 Lot 3 – PhP 1,600,000.00 Lot 4 – PhP 1,000,000.00

E. Question and Answer

• The PBAC Chairperson opened the table for the questions and clarification regarding the procurement project:

Representative of American Technologies Inc. (ATI) queried on pro-rating as indicated in Section V of the Terms of Reference if the contract will not be implemented in January 2021. They argued that their contract with the distributor is for one (1) year (12 months). ATI requested if the pro-rating cost will be applied for manpower only.

The PBAC Chairperson asked the other bidder if they have the same views with ATI.

Representatives of Infocentric Solutions, Inc. and Microdata Systems and Management Inc. seconded the suggestion and request of ATI.

The PBAC Chairperson requested the end-user whether the lock-in subscription period is an industry practice.

The end-user explained that maintenance services for ICT infrastructures that the bidders have contracted with their distributors cover not less than one (1) year and there should be no gap from the previous maintenance services to the new one.

The PBAC Chairperson directed the end-user to check with the Accounting and Budget Divisions on how to proceed with the prorating of the contract cost.

The PBAC will decide whether to come up with a Supplemental Bid Bulletin to resolve the matter.

PBAC may release a Bid Bulletin upon further study and coordination of Enduser with the Accounting and Budget Divisions as regards the issue raised.
